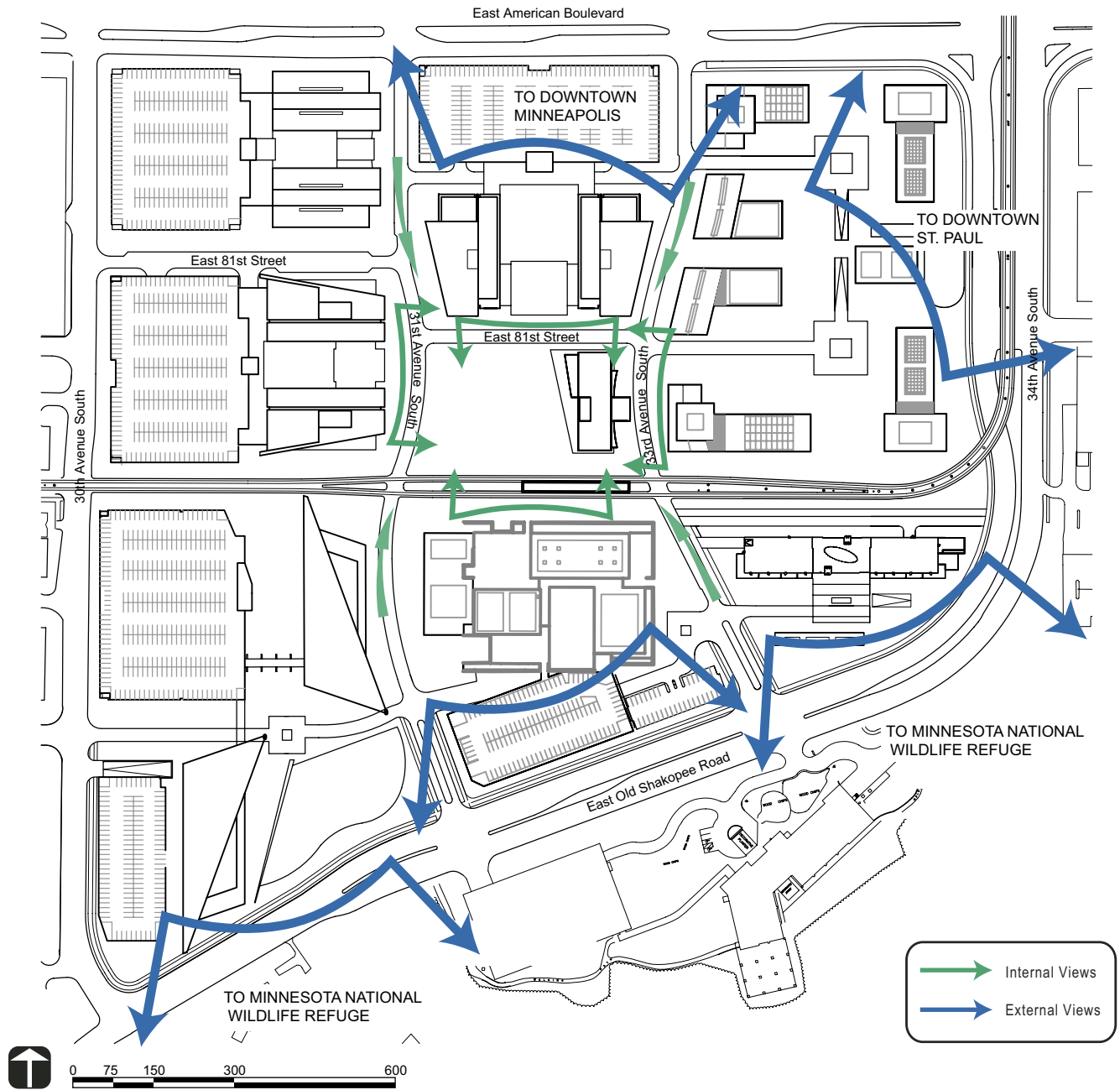


Figure 17: View Corridor Diagram
