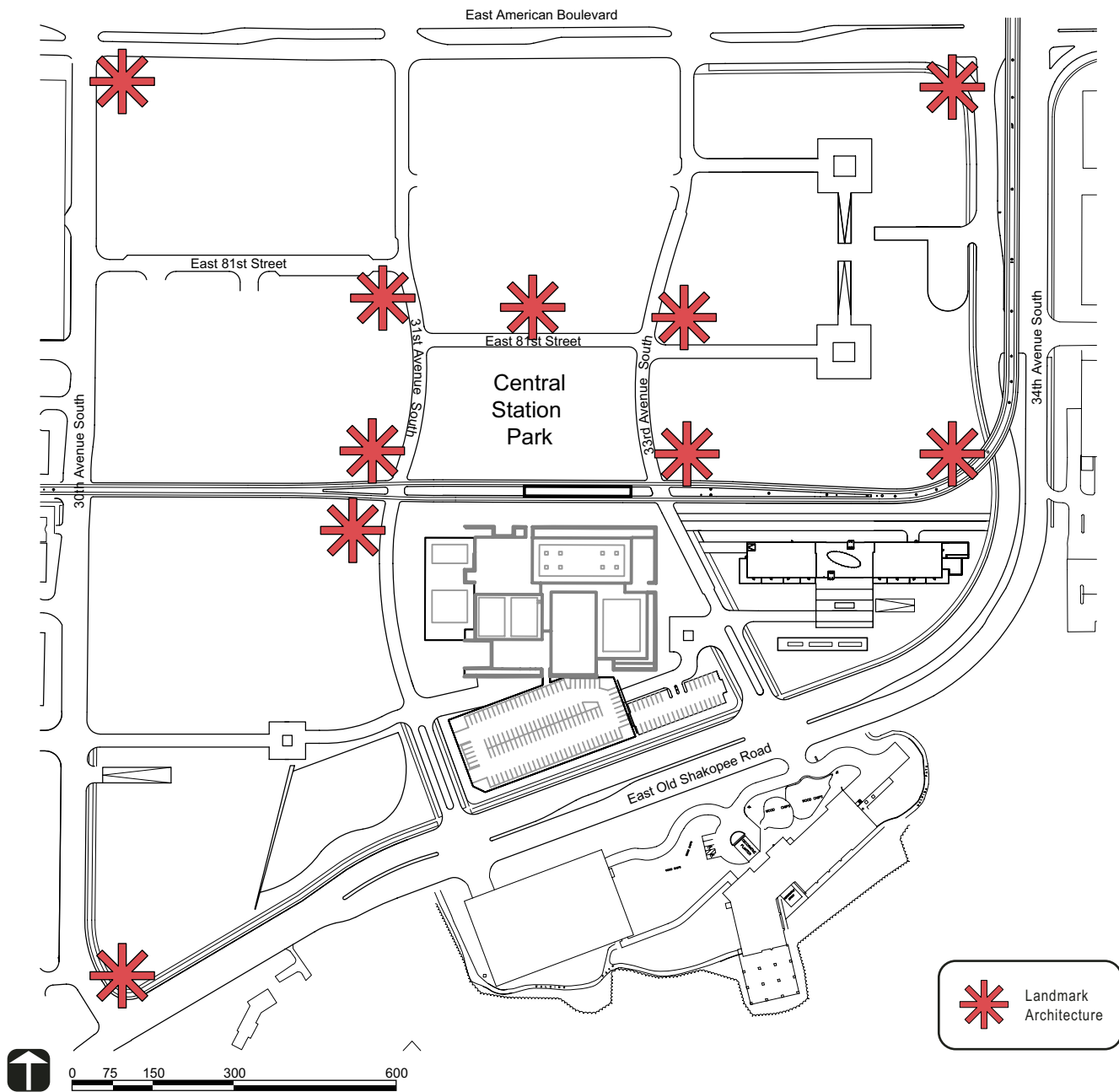


Figure 19: Landmark Location Diagram

- Buildings should have a level of transparency that is fitting with the use and space they are a part of. In particular, retail uses should be highly transparent on the ground floor to bring the indoors out.

Landmark buildings with architecturally unique features such as point towers, curved facades, cantilevered walls, etc. should occur at important corners of the site (See Figure 19: Landmark Location Diagram).
