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2012 League Information

With the fall season underway, the Bloomington Parks and Recreation Division is now accepting registrations for the 2012 Adult Winter Volleyball season.

Play begins January 2nd and continues through March 19th. Teams will play a ten week regular season schedule. Play is offered from competitive to recreational levels in Co-Rec and Women's Divisions.

All matches will be officiated and use the rally scoring method. Teams will compete six players versus six players.

Teams should plan to provide a warm up ball if they desire. One ball will be provided per court during the season.



LEAGUE FEES

Fees include a ten game season, which includes scheduling of a court, court equipment (volleyball, net and poles), game official and t-shirts for the league champions.

Resident League Fees
\$255 + tax = \$273.55

Non-Resident League Fees
\$310 + tax = \$332.55

Teams are considered to be non-resident if the team is not comprised of at least 75% of team members living or working in Bloomington.

A completed registration form and full payment need to be returned to the Parks and Recreation Division. Registrations are accepted via mail, fax or in person. **Registrations will not be accepted over the phone.**

Although registrations are only taken from teams, individuals can ask to be placed on the Volleyball Draft List. This list is distributed to all teams that do register to play league in Bloomington. Teams that are in need of players can contact people off of this list to play for their team. It does not guarantee that individuals will be placed on a team.

2012 Adult League Registration Information

To register for an adult league you will need to take the following steps:

1. Completely fill out the yellow registration form. This includes team name, manager's info, league and night preferred, payment info and signature on the back side. Registrations will not be accepted if the registration form is not completely filled out.
2. Return completed registration form and **full payment** to the

Parks and Recreation Office. Returning team priority registration period closes at the end of the business day on **Wednesday December 7th.**

3. At this point, new teams will be placed into leagues on a first come, first serve basis.
4. Once your team has been entered into a league, you will receive a confirmation packet that will include a receipt and a City roster/waiver form.

IMPORTANT

Completed City roster/waiver form must be turned in prior to your team's first game. Failure to do so will result in your team being penalized with forfeits until a completed form is turned in. All players participating on your team must be on your team's roster form. If they are not listed on your team's roster, they are considered an ineligible player and any match they participate in will be considered a forfeit.
