

River Rendezvous 2012 Admissions, Registration, and Cancellation Policies

Please read the following information carefully.

Admission Fees and Policy

\$9.25 per student – Early bird rate for registrations received before April 16

\$10.25 per student – Schools registering after April 16

\$10.25 per adult* (see below)

* For every 5 children attending, one adult may attend free of charge. For every adult attending above this number, an admission price of \$10.25 will be charged.

Payment Policy

Payment is required before the event or upon arrival that day. If you are unable to pay in advanced please contact Jill Murphy at 952-563-8889 or jmurphy@ci.bloomington.mn.us.

Special Needs Policy

Bloomington Parks and Recreation actively supports the inclusion of all children into our programs. If you or your participant has any special needs, please contact Kari Hemp at 952-563-8891 at least two weeks in advance so we may make arrangements to accommodate you. If special circumstances arise within two weeks of the event, please contact us as soon as possible.

Registration and Scheduling Policy

You may email or mail your registration form to the Bloomington Park and Recreation office. A fill in form is available at www.ci.bloomington.mn.us keyword River Rendezvous. Registration will be on a first-received basis. To ensure that you get your first choice, we cannot stress the importance of returning your completed application as soon as possible.

Please do not over-estimate the number of students that will be attending the event, but be as accurate as possible. You may always add a few students if your actual number is greater than the number you noted on your registration form.

If the number of students or adults changes the change of status form must be received before August 30th. Any changes made after August 30th must pay for all registered students plus any additional students.

The hours of River Rendezvous School Days are 8:55 am to 2:45 pm. Please indicate on your registration form the times at which you would like to start and end your day. Please take into account travel time and traffic concerns when deciding on your arrival and departure times.

A confirmation will be sent to you in May, letting you know we have received your registration and the date your school is scheduled to attend.

Registration Changes Policy

If you wish to change the number of students or adults that you have registered for, you may do so only by mailing or emailing the Change of Status Form included in this packet. A change can be made without penalty until August 30th at 4:00 pm. After that time you will be charged for the amount of people you have registered for. You may also download the Change of Status form by visiting the City of Bloomington website at www.ci.bloomington.mn.us

Students may be added to your group at any time up until the event; however you must email the Change of Status Form to us to do so. If you want to add twenty or more students, you must contact us to make arrangements at 952-563-8889.

After August 30th at 4:00 p.m.	= Must pay for all registered students plus any additional

Cancellation Policy

If your school wishes to cancel its registration, it may do so before July 31st at 4:00 p.m. with no penalty. A cancellation between August 1st and August 13th at 4:00 p.m. will warrant a \$50 cancellation fee. Should you cancel between August 13th and August 30th at 4:00 p.m., you will be charged 50% of the **original** fee. After August 30th at 4:00 p.m., your school will be charged for the number of students and adults that you are registered for, without exception. If a student is sick the day of the event, a refund is not provided. It is recommended that arrangements be made to fill these openings, if possible. If more students attend than is registered, you must provide a check for the additional number of students that day.
