Public Health Nurses (PHNs) in the Family Health Program area work with families in the home and community. Services are often provided in partnership with other organizations and agencies

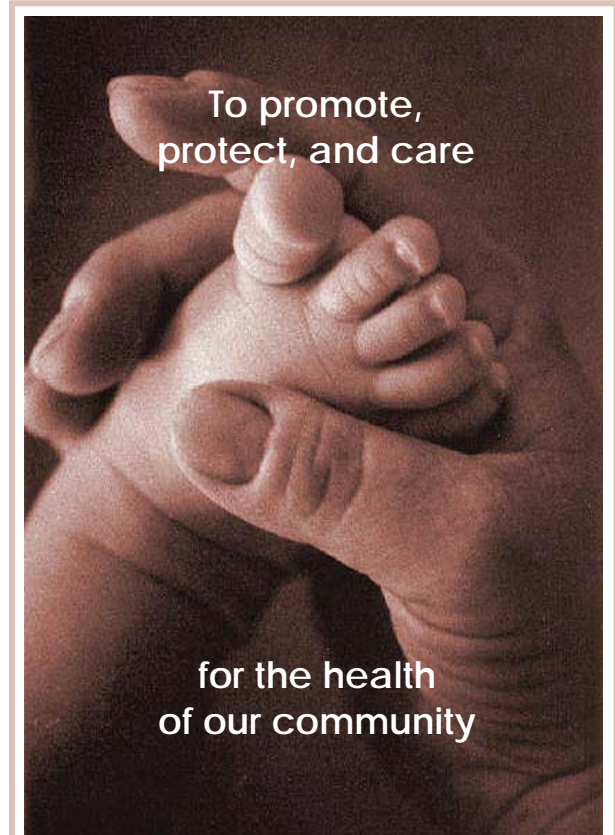

Public Health Nursing Services To Families





Public Health Nurses Can Help with:

- Health and psychosocial concerns
- Pregnancy
- Postpartum recovery and breast-feeding
- New baby care and bonding, attachment
- Children's health, growth, and development concerns
- Parent's health concerns
- Parenting support and education
- Home safety
- Domestic violence or family communication problems
- Lack of medical insurance or health care
- Lack of resources

What do Public Health Nurses do?

- Assess the family as a whole for needs, strengths, and resources
- Attend to the specific health needs of family members
- Provide health screening and physical assessment
- Assist in locating appropriate community resources
- Health counseling
- Health education to individuals and groups
- Service coordination
- Provide nursing care
- Work with families to support health and self-sufficiency
- Document assessment, plan of care, and intervention
- Provide visits to families in their home or other community location

What is a Public Health Nurses (PHN)?

A Public Health Nurse (PHN) is a Registered Nurse with a Certification in Public Health.

Public Health Nurses blend the knowledge of nursing with that of public health and social services

They are skilled in working with high-risk families and diverse cultures.

PHN home visits to families are provided at no cost to the family
