Funding will be distributed in the following manner based on scores:

The total amount of funding available for the 2024 Community Partner Awards is \$24,999.

Applications will be considered for funding based on the following scoring criteria:

- Category 1: Applications receiving between **80-100 points** will be considered for the full amount requested.
- Category 2: Applications receiving between 61-79 points will be considered for full or partial funding, depending on availability.
- Category 3: Applications under 60 points will not be considered for funding.

Reductions: Should the total amount of requested funding by eligible applicants exceed available funding, reductions will begin with proposals that fall into Category 2 and be proportionate to the percent of available funding.
